Not included in this summary are approximately \$41,144 in services Masonic Village at Elizabethtown contributed to the well-being of the community through benefits which are shared among Masonic Village residents and staff and members of the community, including space for GEARS classes and support groups. Through Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreements signed in Dallas, Elizabethtown, Lafayette Hill and Sewickley, we also paid \$2,201,442 to Luzerne, Lancaster and Allegheny counties; Dallas, West Donegal, Whitemarsh and Aleppo Townships; Elizabethtown Borough; and Dallas Area, Elizabethtown Area and Quaker Valley School Districts.
